Handover ceremony of Japanese-Funded project "The Project for Construction of Training Centre Related to the Deaf in Mutare"

On 1st November, 2018, Ambassador Iwado officially opened new school facilities funded by Japan at Nzeve Deaf Children's Center in Mutare District, Manicaland Province. The facilities consist of a training centre and furniture for 50 students including a whiteboard. These were completed through a project implemented by a local NGO, Nzeve Deaf Children's Centre.
