### **Please Note:**

1. Deadline for submission of application forms to the Embassy of Japan is **30 June, 2020**
2. **Only shortlisted** candidates screened by submitted application documents will be advised of further procedures.
3. Applicants for Undergraduate and College of Technology Students **must** have passes in **A-Level Mathematics** and any other 2 subjects related to their area of intended study.
4. In some circumstances such as travel restrictions or curfew, there are possibilities that the selection process will be cancelled or applicants will not be able to come to Japan even after being selected as scholarship students.
