

Completion of Japanese-Funded project “The Project for Improvement of X-ray Equipment of Mashoko Christian Hospital in Bikita District”

Mashoko Christian Hospital in Bikita District unveiled their new digital X-ray machine funded by Japan. The new machine was supported through the Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) Programme. The project was implemented by a Swiss NGO, SolidarMed Zimbabwe.

Previously, patients need travel far distance in order to take abdominal and spinal X-rays as the hospital has only a portable X-ray machine which has limited specification. And that often caused heavy burden on patients both financially and physically.

SolidarMed Zimbabwe received positive feedbacks from hospital and community:

“continuous service is now possible even under power cut as solar power system is also equipped”, “people in the community are happy to have an access to reasonable and quality X-ray” and “patients from neighbouring district now visit to the hospital for X-ray, seeking the improved quality”




