## **Japanese Government MEXT Scholarship 2025 for Research Students, Undergraduate and College of Technology are NOW OPEN**

### **Research Students**

The MEXT Research Scholarship is intended for graduate or post-graduate students to complete a master's or doctoral degree at a Japanese institution.

Applicants must explain their intended field of study in the application and should take care to explain why they wish to complete their degree in Japan and how their research will benefit Zimbabwe-Japan relations. It should be related to their undergraduate field of study and should be a program which they can pursue at a Japanese university. The scholarship is open to students pursuing any major and is typically for a period of two years or the length of time to complete the degree program, including a six-month term of intensive Japanese language training. The term of the 2025 MEXT Research Scholarship is from April 2025 to March 2027 with the possibility of extension.

Applicants should research universities in Japan before applying to understand what programs are available and whether they will accept international students.
