Last year, the export of Zimbabwean sesame seeds to Japan started for the first time and the export of petalite, which is essential for the production of Banko-yaki earthenware pots, has been resumed after two years.

Zimbabwe is scheduled to have a pavilion at the Osaka-Kansai Expo 2025 starting in April this year, and TICAD 9 will be held in Yokohama this August, which is expected to further develop bilateral relations, including personnel exchanges such as visits of Zimbabwean high-level dignitaries to Japan.

The number of annual visitors to Zimbabwe from Japan is close to 10,000. In order to dispel the old negative image of Zimbabwe, we are encouraging as many people as possible to come to experience not only the tourist spots such as Victoria Falls and safaris, but also the charm of Zimbabwe's rich nature and friendly people.
